<p><b>Gift Cards</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>For home improvement, grocery and/or department stores</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>Nursery &amp; Play Therapy Supplies</b></p> <p>Please do not include stuffed animals, blankets, construction paper, or crayons. We are fully stocked on them.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Craft supplies: rubber cement, feathers, fabric flowers, jewels, etc.</li> <li>• <b>Diapers sizes 4, 5 and 6</b></li> <li>• Ethnic dolls</li> <li>• Mini Flashlights</li> <li>• <b>New girls' underwear</b> (sizes 2T-10)</li> <li>• <b>New boys' underwear</b> (sizes 2T-5)</li> <li>• New toy rifles/toy guns/swords/light sabers</li> <li>• New boys and girls clothing (sizes 2T-4T and 8T-10T)</li> <li>• Blankets (Toddler size or bigger)</li> <li>• New dollhouse furniture</li> <li>• <b>Disposable paper plates</b> (dinner and small size) and cups</li> <li>• <b>Baby Wipes</b></li> </ul>

## Food Donation Guidelines

Acceptable Donations
FOOD MUST BE UNEXPIRED
Any whole foods
Baby food/formula*
Bread/Tortillas
Butter/Margarine
Crackers/Pretzels/Fruit Snacks
Cheese
Fresh/frozen/canned fruits and vegetables
Fresh/frozen/canned meats that are 100% one meat (no fillers, no mixed meat products)
Gluten free pastas and breads
Milk (ONLY 1% and Whole)
Pastas
Yogurt

Unacceptable Donations
ANY EXPIRED FOOD
Dessert grains (donuts, pastries, etc.)
Meat products that are not 100% one meat (e.g. no hot dogs or sausage unless they are 100% beef or 100% pork)
Milk (Skim, 2%)
Processed foods without children's nutrition label

\*Please no large quantities of baby formula.
